The CRSC Feasibility Review is a cross-functional, objective review of study readiness. It is conducted by experienced research professionals and assists the investigator and study team in connecting with resources.

This optional service is **free of charge**.

- Study-specific recommendations to strengthen the protocol
- Connections to resources & tools
- Decreased study start-up timeline
